President's Report: Jeff asked for a volunteer to serve on the North Park Village Advisory Board and Christine Rosenberg has stepped up to fill this role. Jeff announced that the committee to create a resident survey on how ECA dues should be allocated will meet on Wednesday October 16th at Nancy's house. The committee is chaired by Michelle Christensen and include the following directors: Mary B. Tom M, Nora S., Nancy W., and Justin.

Vice President's Report: The Spookiest House judging will be on Monday October 28th. Nancy passed out a flyer with the details and cost. Board members are encouraged to participate. Please RSVP Nancy by October 21st. Friends and spouses are invited.

Treasurer's Report: Jeff Singer shared the updated 2019 ECA budget. The budget update reflects an off budget Holiday light expense that was approved by the Board earlier this year.

Secretary's Report: Nancy and Mary met with Alderman Napolitano several weeks ago and discussed the changes to his Advisory Board. Christine will continue to monitor all Zoning issues in the Edgebrook neighborhood and advise the board of any proposed changes. The secretary reminded board members that our next meeting would be held on WEDNESDAY, November 6th at the library.

Director's Reports

Nominating Committee: There are two candidates for the board that have been vetted and are considered strong candidates. Several other names have surfaced and are being contacted. The nominating committee will present our slate at the next board meeting.

Programs: The next General meeting will be held in on November 19th at Edgebrook School at 6:30 pm. Sarah Langford from https://onthequadconsulting.com/ will present and answer questions about the

college admission process. The Spookiest House winners will be presented as well as the new slate of candidates for the board.

Special Events: The Holiday Stroll is once again scheduled for the Sunday after Thanksgiving December 1st. Santa is booked from 2pm until 5pm. Nancy requested an additional \$250.00 for the Holiday Stroll expense. Motion was made and approved unanimously. Jennifer and Mary will run the craft area and Michelle will seek Girl Scout volunteers to help.

Community Development: Top Driver is leaving and a Pediatric Vision Center will be opening in the same location. The corner block of stores (Lee Nails and more) is up for sale for \$1.5 million. The daycare center next to Starbucks has closed and the landlord is seeking a new day care operator.

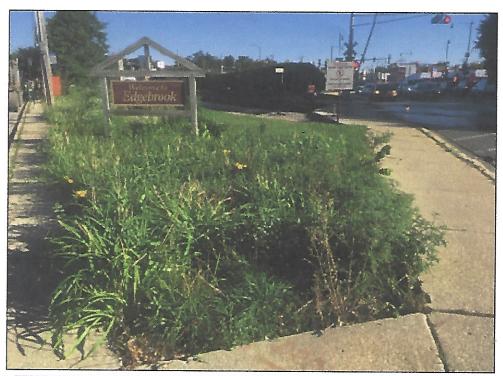
